It's About Time: Fast Time/Slow Time

Read Exodus 31:12-17

"You shall keep my Sabbaths, for this is a sign between me and you."

An invisible line runs down through the cornfields of Indiana. You can't see it, but every Hoosier knows where it is. The line divides the state into two time zones. In Indiana, they refer to it as "fast time and slow time." You can live on one side of the line and work on the other, which means you are constantly doing the conversion. It's important to know where you are if you want to know what time it is. I don't understand Indiana time zones, but I do know the difference between "fast time" and "slow time." Fast time is where I live most of the time. Slow time is what I need. The Bible calls that "Sabbath time." During Lent, we are invited to slow down and take the time to remember where we are and who we are and what time it is. During Lent, step across the line into "slow time."

Prayer: Slow me down, Lord, and grant me the gift of Sabbath time in the midst of "fast time" until I discover you present in all of time. Amen.
