"Set Your Mind on The Spirit of God"

More often than I would like to admit, I give into the feeling that God doesn't pay too much attention to what is going on in my life. God has more important matters upon which to concentrate. In some ways this is healthy. It's true that God attends to a lot more crucial matters than what is occurring in my life. On the other hand, I tend to forget that God is so all powerful and everywhere present that I cannot begin to fathom all God is capable of doing.

More often than I would like to admit, I treat God as if the world's problems, our country's problems, our state's problems, our city's problems, our community's problems, our church's problems are more than God can handle.

If we think it is up to humanity to solve the earth's problems, then we should not have to spend hard earned money going to a psychiatrist to ask the question, "Why am I so depressed?" If we think that God does not get involved, then we will begin to feel like we are being buried alive by the world's suffering and pain. We will continue to stoop lower and lower as we feel each segment of "bad news" pile on to our shoulders: the U.S. economy, the weakening dollar, the housing crisis, the rising cost of gas, the war in Iraq, the inability of Congress to work together to make the world better, the struggling church in the U.S.A., balancing the budget at home and in the church; the list goes on and on and on...

I'm not quite sure why it is that "when the going gets tough," our sinful nature tends to kick in and we put on blindfolds over faith treating faith as nothing more than *make believe*. Followers of Jesus Christ walk in the awareness of the fact that he is the source of light. For instance, remember the man who was healed by Jesus Christ of his blindness. After he was healed, he told everyone he met, *This I know. I once was blind, but now I see*. Persons of faith *see* that God is much bigger than the challenges we face. God equips us to face the challenges and grow through them.

The apostle Paul put it like this. *To set the mind on the flesh is death, but to set the mind on the Spirit is life and peace. (Romans 8:6)*. In other words, to act as if Christ is not part of our lives and bigger than the challenges we face is to shrivel up and die. When we trust that God is bigger than us and the problems we face, we set our minds on his Spirit and look for him to act through us in ways we never dreamed possible. Setting our minds totally on God brings life and peace and wholeness.

Set our minds on you, Lord Jesus Christ.
