"Jesus Christ: The Gate Way to Abundant Living"

Usually I don't pay much attention to gateways. About the only time I look at them closely occurs when they don't function properly. Then I do my best to figure what the right combination is to get the handle to release.

According to the Gospel writer of John, Jesus Christ gave us several different metaphors to help us perceive the mystery of his identity. For instance, Jesus referred to himself as *The Good Shepherd* and *The Gate for The Sheep*. (Please read John 10:1-10.)

How do these two metaphors incorporated into a relatively brief section of scripture tie together? Here is what comes to mind. Jesus Christ, The Good Shepherd, who laid down his life to save humanity from the separation from God brought on by human sinfulness and brokenness; is the gate to God and the benefits of his relationship with God.

In other words, as followers and sheep of Jesus Christ, we allow him to carry us into deeper communion with God. This leads to abundant living. There is no limit to the gift of life that Jesus dispenses.

Praise God, in order to enter into abundant living, we don't have to fumble with the handle on the gate way to God. All we have to do is to allow Jesus Christ to carry us. Perhaps that's easier said than done.

God, grant us the courage to enter into deeper communion with you.
