**APPALACHIA SERVICE PROJECT**

We can be proud of the forty volunteers we are sending to minister to and to work on the homes of the poor in the mountains of West Virginia.

As part of serving in this area, our teams will be taking old Sunday School literature and devotional material to be distributed during our week there.

Our group will be leaving for this ASP project on Sunday, June 21st.



The theme for ASP 2009 is Putting Faith Forward! "Now faith is the substance of things hoped for, the evidence of things not seen". Hebrews 11:1 .

We are fortunate to have 40 youth and adults going on ASP 2009. We will host the group of 80 folks. Together we will provide 11 work crews and 1 support truck.

We will be serving in Logan County, West Virginia. Many things will be learned about relationships and Christian faith through this ministry to the poor.

ASP was created in 1969 by the Rev. Glenn "Tex" Evans. As United Methodist Pastor in Frakes, Kentucky. "Tex" witnessed the great need for extensive home repair. Matching the need for home repair with enthusiastic young people, Tex organized the first ASP work camp.

**1969:** Tex enlisted 50 volunteers to repair 4 homes.

**2008:** ASP hosted 12,749 volunteers serving 384 families
