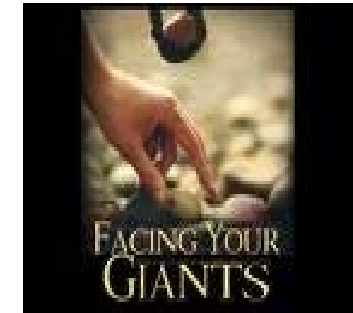

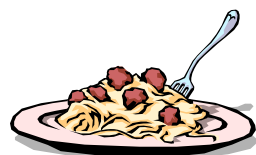
The Greensboro District UMM Prayer Breakfast will be held
