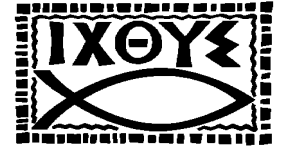

MISSIONS

The missions team met and distributed the following funds.

1. \$209.79 from the February 5th hunger pot was sent to Accra, Ghana, Africa for the "Hope for Teenage Mothers" fund to educate teenage mothers in pomade making, crocheting, beadwork and family care. This helps young mothers provide for their families.
2. \$104.05 from the Annie Dever Fund to be distributed for world hunger was sent to Sierra Leone, Africa to the Harford Secondary and June Hartranft Memorial School feeding program to prevent malnutrition as a result of the recent war.
3. \$486.63 from the Lenten offering (church banks) was given to ASP.
4. \$316.00 from the Easter Lily Fund was given to Faith Action.
5. 358.40 from the collection for UMCOR Sunday "One Hour of Sharing" was sent to UMCOR in New York.
6. 17 Shoeboxes for Samaritan's Purse "Operation Christmas Child" have been delivered to Samaritan's Purse in Boone, N.C. We have a church-wide goal of 100 shoeboxes for this year.
7. The May 5th Sunday Hunger Pot money will be given to the Heifer Project International.
